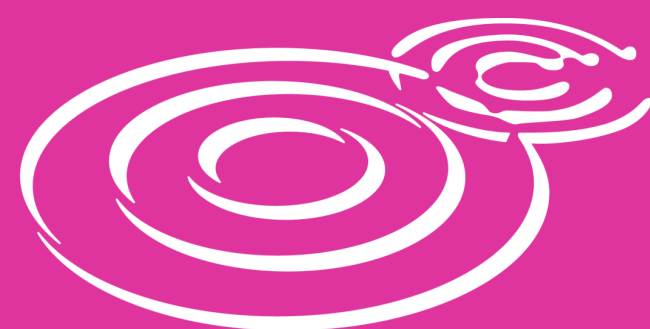

**Networking** - Able to meet new people and negiate a working relationship.

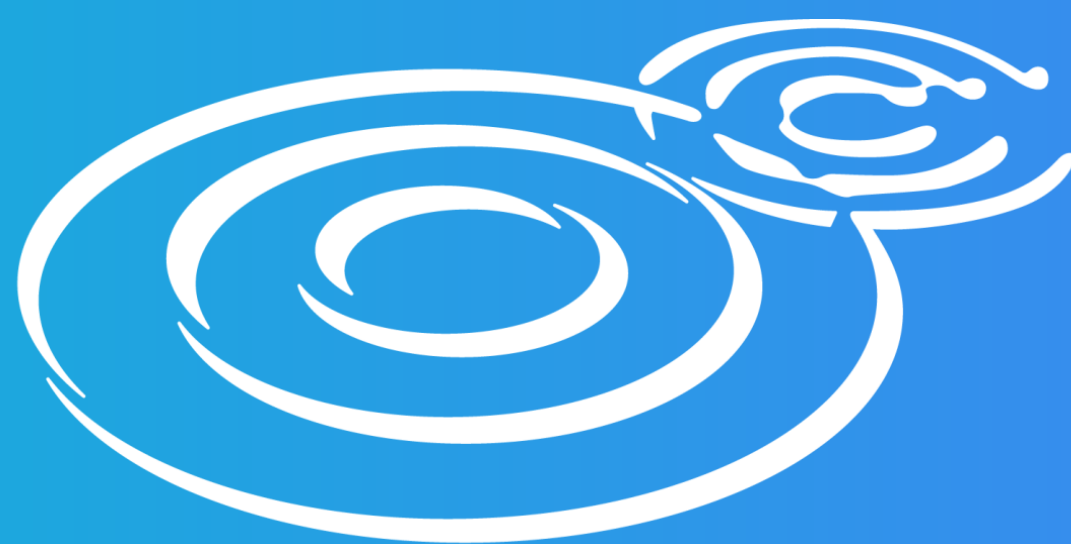
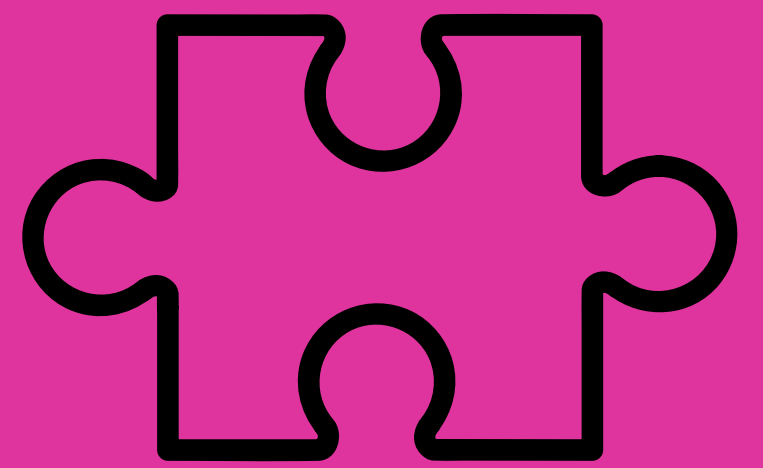
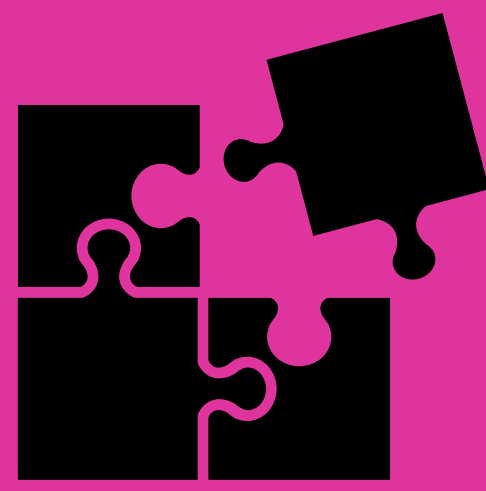
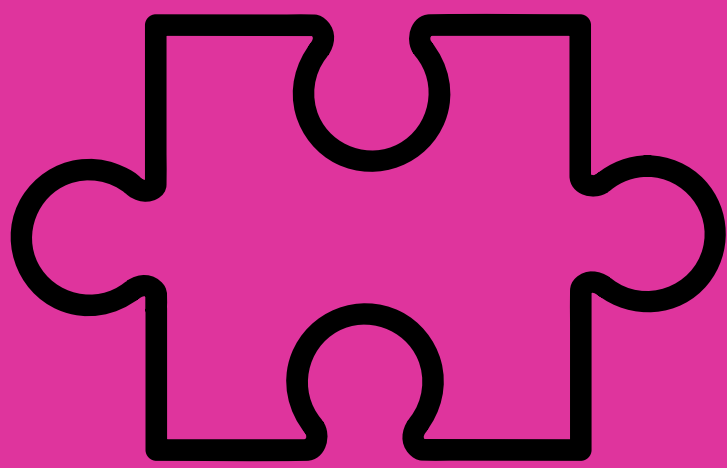
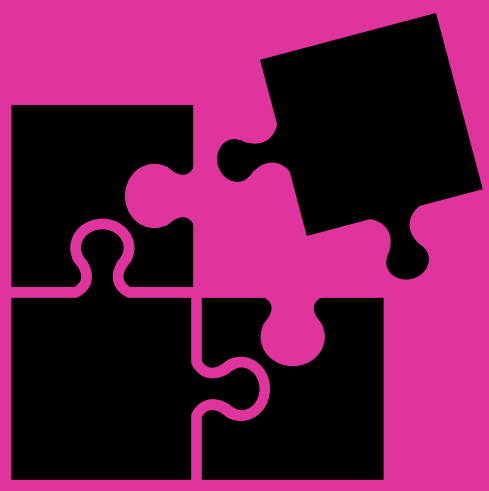
**Negotiating** - Negotiation is a method by which people settle differences.
